Financial decision-making for wildfire survivors

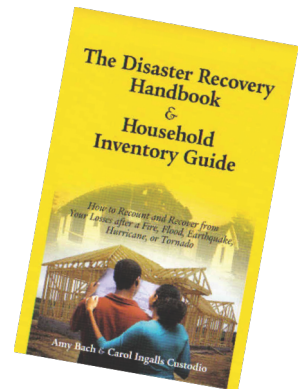
