



- Local government, including:
 - Cities, county, or city and county
 - Fire protection districts
 - Community services districts
 - Water districts
 - Resource conservation districts
 - Special districts
- Non-profit organizations with a 501(c)3
 - Fire Safe Councils
- Tribal Entities
- State & Federal Agencies



Wildfire Prevention Grants Key Dates

Solicitation period to open November 2023

- Close date January 2024
- Awards in spring/early summer 2024.
