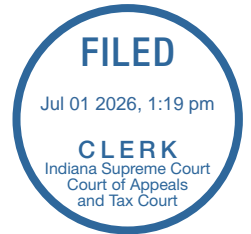

Proposed amicus curiae United Policyholders states that it is a non-profit, tax-exempt, charitable organization that educates and assists individual and business consumers on insurance matters and works to secure the loss indemnity objective for which people buy insurance. Proposed amicus is substantively aligned with the appellee, which filed its petition to transfer on June 26, 2026.
